



Community Service Award for Fellows and Members

- Purpose:*** Recognize fellows and members for their participation in community leadership and volunteer projects.
- Criteria:*** Involvement in volunteer health or service related projects of benefit to the community that are not a regular part of a personal educational experience.
- Eligibility:*** All current AAOMS fellows and members.
- Selection:*** Nominations can be made in writing by any fellow or member, and should contain documentation of the activity for which the nomination is being made. There is no limit to the number of awards that can be made each year, but a nominee can only be recognized once for the same activity even though it extends over more than one year.
- Award:*** A certificate of recognition and a description of the activity published in *AAOMS Today*.
