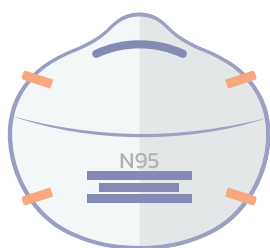


Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) Resources

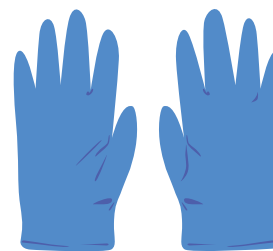
