

Application Instructions

- All interested candidates must submit the following materials with this application:
 - Curriculum vitae
 - Letter of recommendation from a faculty member
 - A signed letter of approval by the applicants' Program Director. The letter of approval will be provided by ROAAOMS and will outline the responsibilities that the applicant will assume upon being selected to serve as an Executive Committee member.
- District representative positions** will be appointed by the presiding ROAAOMS Executive Committee (EC). District Representatives can apply to serve for an optional second year. Applicants must have eighteen (18) months of OMS training remaining.
- Committee liaison positions** will be appointed by the presiding ROAAOMS officers (President, Vice President, and Immediate Past President). Applicants must have served previously on the ROAAOMS EC.
- The Vice President position** will be appointed by the AAOMS Board of Trustees based on the recommendation provided by the officers of ROAAOMS. Applicants must have served previously on the ROAAOMS EC and have at least eighteen (18) months of OMS training remaining.
- Non-categorical OMS residents will not be eligible to serve on the Executive Committee.
- All appointments will be announced in August.
